

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Mini Stirrup Hunter: A single class, not included in the Mini Stirrup Championship. Open to horses & ponies ridden by junior exhibitors 10 years of age & under as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders may have never competed in any division at any horse show competition where cantering is required or fence height is 2' or higher. At that time, the rider is no longer eliqible for Mini Stirrup Hunter Division. Fences are cross rails below 18" or rails on ground.

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to horses & ponies ridden by junior exhibitor 12 years of age & under as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders may have never shown in any division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. To be shown over a course less than 2' in height. To be judged on manners, performance & suitability. Riders may not cross enter into any other division or class at any competition other than Short Stirrup Equitation. This division may be combined with Beginner Hunter, if needed.

Beginner Hunter: Open to horses & ponies ridden by riders of ANY age. Fences LESS THAN 2' in height. Section A: Rider may not have shown in a division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Riders in section A may not cross enter in any division or class at any competition where fences are 2' or higher. The rider will be no longer eligible for Beginner's. Section B: Horse or pony not to have shown in a division, at any competition, where fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Horses may not cross enter into any division or class where fences are 2' or higher at the same competition. This division may be combined with Short Stirrup Hunter, if needed. TROTTING ON COURSE NOT TO BE PENALIZED, ALTHOUGH AN UNINTENTIONAL BREAK OF GAIT WILL BE PENALIZED.

Princeton/Suitable Hunter 3': Open to all riders on horses and ponies. To be shown over a course of fences 3' in height.

Princeton/Schooling Hunter 2'6: Open to all riders on horses and ponies. To be shown over a course of fences 2'6 in height.

Princeton Hunter 2': Open to all riders on horses and ponies. To be shown over a course of fences 2' in height.

Low Children's Hunter: Open to horses & ponies ridden by junior riders who are still eligible to compete as limit riders as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences 2' for ponies. Fences 2'6" for horses. May be combined with low adult hunter. May be split between horses and ponies if more than three riders in each section. Riders may not cross enter into Children's Hunter horse or pony, Pony Hunter, or any class at the same competition where the fences exceed 2'6".

Low Adult Hunter: Open to horses & ponies ridden by an adult amateur exhibitor. To be shown over a course of fences 2'6" in height. Riders may not cross enter into any class or division with fences 3' or higher.

Children's Hunter: To be shown by a junior exhibitor. Riders on horses may not cross enter into class where fences exceed 3' at the same competition except (Children's Jumper, and Equitation classes that do not exceed 3'6'). Horses and ponies may be jogged for soundness at the discretion of the judge. Class may be split between horses and ponies if more than three in each section. Combined with adult amateur hunter. To be run in accordance with USEF/USJHA Zone 2 Specifications. Fences 3' for Horses, 2'6" for Large ponies, 2' for Sm/Med ponies.

Adult Amateur Hunter: To be shown by exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors, who possess a valid current USEF Amateur Card. Ponies may be shown by adults; suitability to count. Fences 3', spreads not to exceed fence heights. To be run in accordance with USEF/USHJA Zone 2 specifications. Combined with Children's Hunter.

Mini Stirrup Equitation: Open to junior exhibitors 10 years of age & under as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders may have never shown in any division at any competition where cantering is required or they are no longer eliqible for the Mini Stirrup division. Riders not to have shown over fences 2' or higher at a USEF recognized show.

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to junior exhibitors 12 years of age & under as of December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over a course less than 2' in height. Riders may never have shown in any division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Riders may not cross enter into any other division or class where fence heights are 2' or higher. This division may be combined with Beginner Equitation, if there are less than 3 exhibitors in each section.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Beginner Equitation: Open to exhibitors of any age who have not shown in a division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. To be shown over a course less than 2'. Riders may not cross enter into any other division or class where fences are 2' or higher. This division may be combined with Short Stirrup Equitation if there are less than 3 exhibitors in each section. TROTTING ON COURSE NOT TO BE PENALIZED, ALTHOUGH AN UNINTENTIONAL BREAK OF GAIT WILL BE PENALIZED.

Modified Rider 2'3": Open to junior and amateur exhibitors on horses or ponies. Riders to show over a simple course with fences at 2'3". Riders not to have shown over fences 2'6" or higher in the previous show year. Exhibitors cannot cross enter into any other class/division where fences are higher than 2'3" at the same competition. Riders who have competed in a rated division which includes Pre-Children's horses and Low Adult in the past show year are not eligible to compete in this class.

Low Children's Equitation: Open to junior riders who are still eligible to compete as limit riders as of December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over a course of eight (8) fences, with one change of direction. Fences 2' for ponies. Fences 2'6" for horses. Riders may not cross enter into Children's Hunter horse or pony, Pony Hunter or any class at the same competition where fences exceed 2'6".

Children's Equitation 3' Classes 62-65: Open to junior riders who have not won six (6) blue ribbons at a recognized show as of December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over at least eight (8) fences 3' in height with at least one change of direction. Riders may not have won any equitation class at 3'6" or higher prior to December 1st of the current show year.

Children's/Adult Medal 2'6": Open to junior riders on horses or ponies and adult amateur riders that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height of 2'6' including a combination and two changes of direction after the first fence.

Children's Medal 2', 2'6", 3': Open to riders in children/adult hunter division. Fences 2' for small-medium ponies, fences 2'6" for large ponies, and fences 3' for horses/adults. May be split between ponies and horses if entries warrant. May be combined with PEL Adult Medal.

Adult Medal 3': Open to all adult amateurs. To be shown over a minimum of eight (8) fences at 3'. May be combined with the Ariat Adult Medal or the Marshall & Sterling Adult medal. May also be combined with PEL Children's Medal.

Lead Line: Open to exhibitors 6 years of age and under as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders may not cross enter into any other classes at the same show.

Leap Frog Jumper .60m: Open to all horses and ponies who, as a horse & rider combination, have not won a total of \$1000 in jumper classes as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences 2' in height, no oxers or combinations.

Itty Bitty Jumper: Open to all horses & ponies who, as a horse & rider combination, have not won a total of \$1000 in jumper classes as of December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over fences .70m in height, no combinations.

Pre-Children's/Adult Jumper: Open to junior/amateur riders who have not won more than \$1000 in jumper classes as of December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over fences .80m in height.

Low Children's/Adult Jumper: Open to horses or ponies ridden by junior or adult amateur riders. To be shown over fences .90m in height, concurrent with USEF Low Children/Adult jumper. Neither horse nor rider may compete in any classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'6" in the 1st round, except the USEF Talent Search.

High Children's/Adult Jumper: Open to horses or ponies ridden by junior or adult amateur riders. To be shown over fences 1.10m to 1.15m in height. Neither horse nor rider may compete in any classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'6" in the 1st round, except the USEF Talent Search.

\$500 M&S High Children's/Adult Jumper Classic: 12 to fill. Otherwise, it will run as a sweepstakes.

USHJA Outreach Points

Riders and trainers must have a USHJA membership at the free Outreach level or higher in order to earn points in Outreach classes. Horses do not need to be registered or microchipped to participate, but if they wish to earn points in the Outreach program, they must be recorded with USHJA (\$75/lifetime).

DIRECTIONS TO HUNTER FARMS, 1315 GREAT RD, PRINCETON, NJ:

FROM THE SOUTH: Route 95 North to Route 206 North. (Lawrenceville Exit #7). 6 miles to Elm Road traffic light. Turn left onto Elm Road. Hunter Farms is 4 miles on the right – just after Cherry Valley Road traffic light. Enter 2nd Driveway!

FROM ROUTE 1: Exit Route 1 onto 571 towards Princeton. Follow Route 571 about 2 miles to Nassau Street/Route 27. Turn left onto Nassau Street/Route 27. At the junction with Route 206 bear left onto 206 south. At second light turn right onto Elm Road. Hunter Farms is 4 miles on the right – just after Cherry Valley Road traffic light. Enter 2nd Driveway!

FROM THE NORTH: Route 206 South to Right Turn at traffic light onto Route 601 South/Trent Ave. Follow about 8 miles to Hunter Farms on the left.

FROM FLEMINGTON: Route 202 South to Route 31 South to left onto Route 518 East.. Bear left in Hopewell to stay on Route 518. About 6 miles past Hopewell turn right onto Route 601 at traffic light (see golf course on right) Hunter Farms is about 2 miles on the left.

Agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, they authorize the competition management to market, transfer, assign or otherwise make use of any photographs, likenesses, film, broadcasts, cablecasts, audiotapes or videotapes taken of the horse(s) and participant(s) while on the grounds, incident, to or in transit between the stabling facility and the event site. In any way they see fit for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the event, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur status nor endorses a specific product or service and to invasion of privacy, right of publicity or to misappropriation, and 5.
